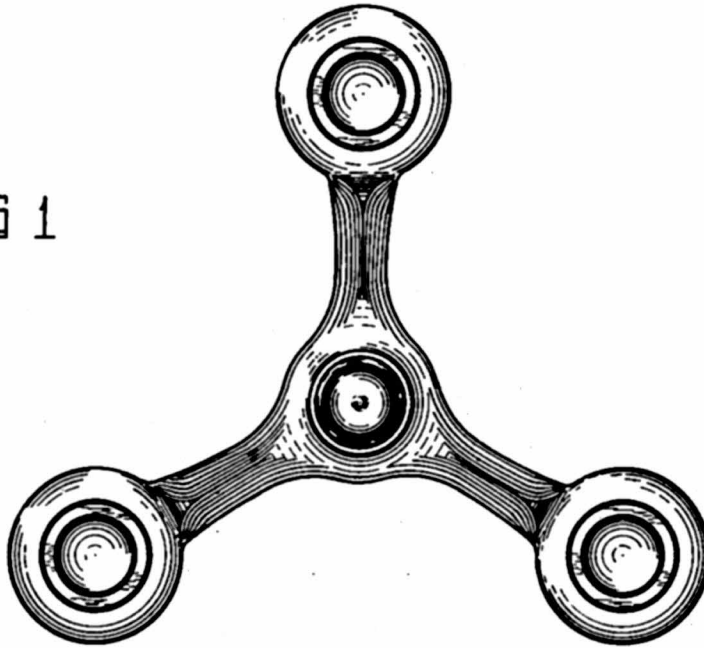

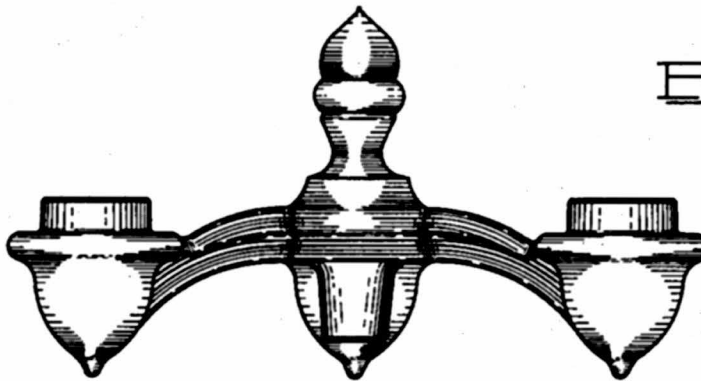
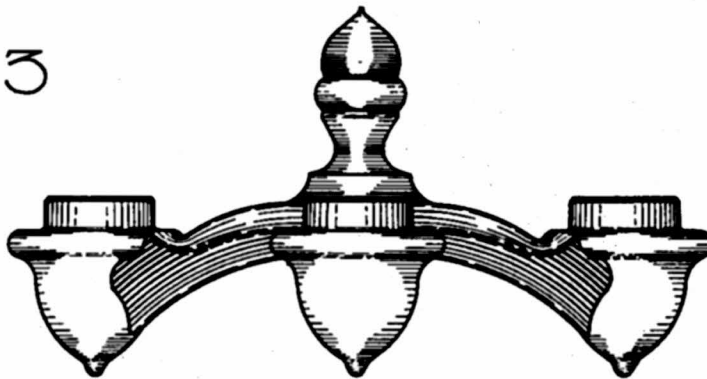

DESIGN FOR A CANDELABRUM OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Wilbur L. Orme, a citizen of the United States of America and resident of Cambridge, county of Guernsey, and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Candelabrum or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof, in which—

Figure 1 is a top elevational view of a candelabrum or similar article, showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a side elevational view of the same; and

Figure 3 is another side elevational view of the

design, the candelabrum in said view occupying a position approximately 120° from that depicted in Fig. 2.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a candelabrum or similar article, substantially as shown.
