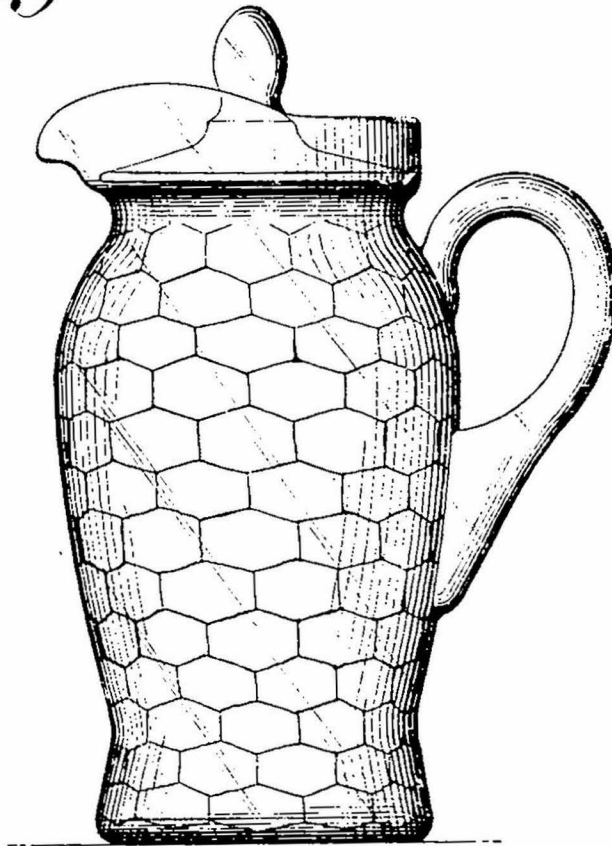
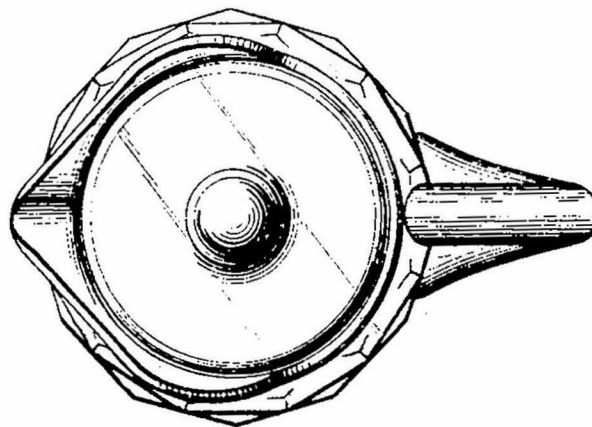

DESIGN FOR A JUG OR SIMILAR ARTICLE.

Application filed January 29, 1925. Serial No. 12,179. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ARTHUR J. BENNETT, a citizen of the United States, residing at Cambridge, in the county of Guernsey and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Jug or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a side elevation showing my new design of jug or similar article, and Figure 2 is a top plan view.
