

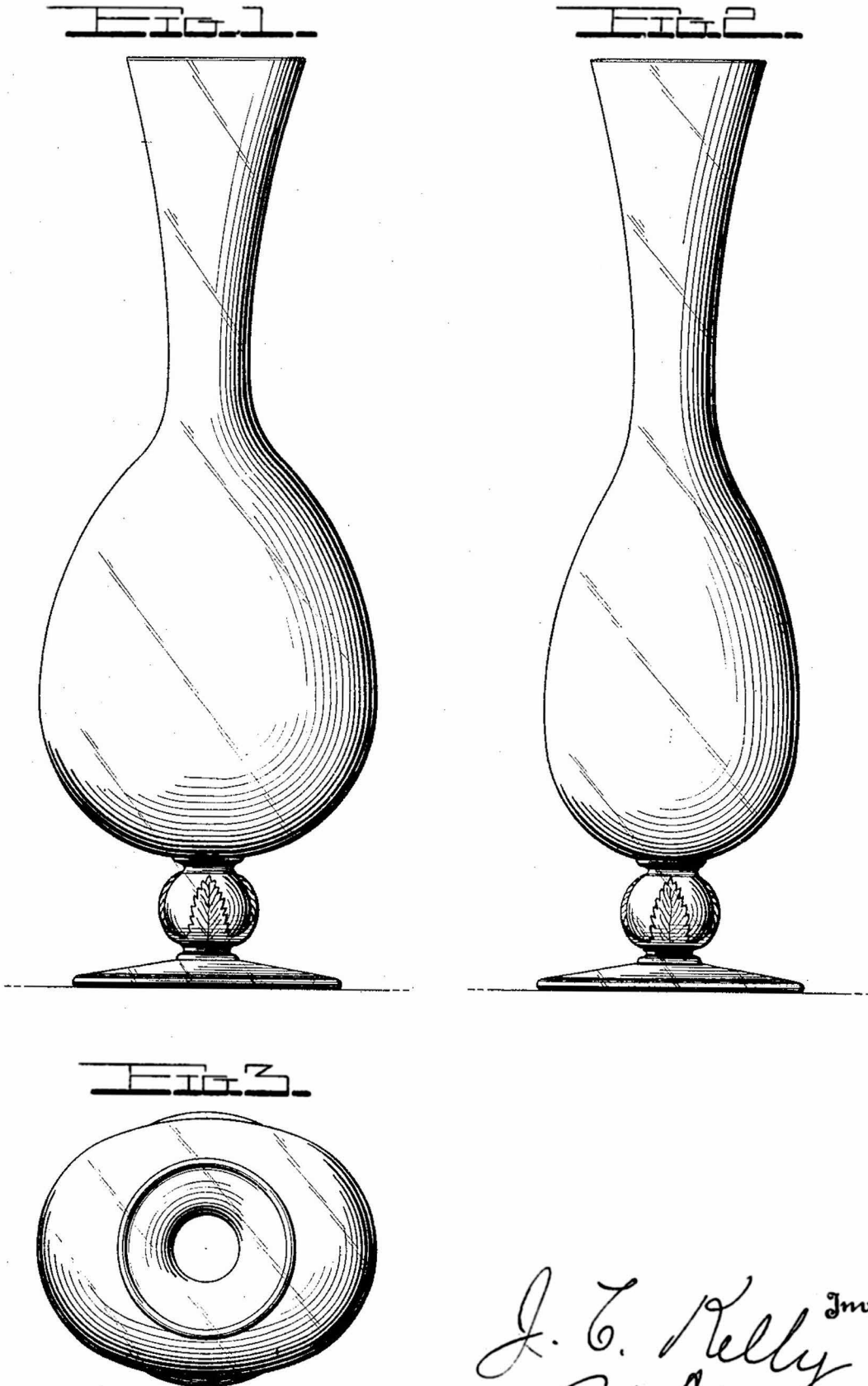

DESIGN FOR A VASE

Application filed February 1, 1929. Serial No. 29,876. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JESS CLAIR KELLY, a citizen of the United States, residing at Cambridge, in the county of Guernsey and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Vase, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front elevation of a vase showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevation, and

Fig. 3 is a top plan view.
