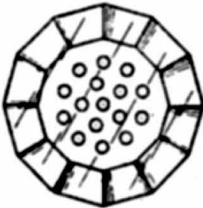

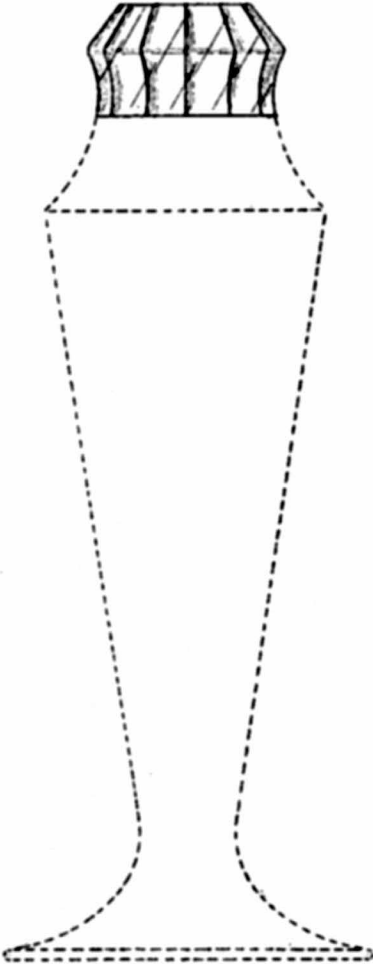

DESIGN FOR A SALT AND PEPPER SHAKER

Application filed September 6, 1930. Serial No. 36,885. Term of patent 14 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, JESS CLAIR KELLY, a citizen of the United States of America, and resident of Cambridge, county of Guernsey, and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Salt and Pepper Shaker, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, in which—

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of a salt and pepper shaker, showing my new design; and—

Fig. 2 is a side elevation of the same.
